

ProStart is a nationwide program for high school students that focuses on developing the next generation of restaurant and foodservice leaders. The program is industry-driven, combining culinary arts and restaurant management training to build practical skills. ProStart provides students a platform to discover new interests while highlighting successful career opportunities across the industry.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- Students participate in a two-year curriculum, take two national exams, complete a minimum of 400 hours of industry work experience and demonstrate mastery in employability skills
- ProStart graduates are eligible to receive the National ProStart Certificate of Achievement (COA), a post-secondary and industry-recognized certificate that can result in scholarships and credits towards apprenticeship, academic and work experience
